Adult & Youth Fall Sunday School Classes

Exodus

Teaching: Phil Bishop, Jonathan Guin, Mike Picone in the Fellowship Hall Duration: Full semester, August 25 - December 15

The Book of Exodus recounts how God graciously delivered Israel from slavery in Egypt, traces their journey through the wilderness, and describes God's covenant with His people at Mount Sinai. Exodus highlights for us a God who delivers rebellious sinners out of his faithfulness and mercy. This class will go chapter by chapter through this amazing book.

A Man and His Traps — Men's Class

Facilitating: Marc Sherrill, Tim Thomassian in the Library Duration: 12 weeks, August 25 - November 10

This class is designed to help men identify and address the potential traps and idols in our hearts that can distract us from the truth and the power of the gospel. Participants will watch DVD sessions one week, followed by small group discussions on the session the following week. Each participant will need a training guide for the study. Copies will be available on the 25th for \$10.

God and Money

Teaching: Keith Watson in the Annex

Duration: 12 weeks, August 25 - November 10

What is God's purpose for our material wealth, and how can we glorify Him through our stewardship of our time and material blessings? This 12week class addresses these questions and more, such as practical wisdom on such topics such as spending and budgeting and stewarding our time while also addressing the heart issues of how we value material things.

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Identity in Christ

Teaching: TBD in the Library

Duration: 5 weeks, November 17 - December 15

As Christians our core identity is to be found in our relationship with Jesus Christ. This class will explore the awesome truths of who we are in Christ. Teachers will be utilizing Who Am I? Identity in Christ by Jerry Bridges as a resource; participants are invited, but not required, to read this book.

Sex and the Supremacy of Christ

Teaching: Jeremy Henderson, Ben Talmadge in the Annex Duration: 5 weeks, November 17 - December 15

The purpose of this class is to help us continue forming a Biblical outlook on sex. Our pastor will be preaching a series this fall on Biblical sexuality, and this class will provide a great opportunity to continue thinking about the Biblical truths on this important topic. In teaching this class teachers will be using selected chapters from Sex and The Supremacy of Christ, edited by John Piper and Justin Taylor. Participants are invited, but not required, to read this book.

Matthew — Youth Class

Teaching: team of youth parents in an Annex classroom

Duration: Full semester, August 25 - December 15

This study will focus on Jesus as the Messiah; how he came, what he did, what he said, and what he accomplished in his death and resurrection. These things are more than just good stories, they are truths intended to change both our lives and the lives of those around us.

Children's Promotion for Sunday School, Pioneer Clubs, & Youth is as follows:

- Infants—not walking well
- Toddlers—one year old AND walking well
 Infants and toddlers promote on a quarterly basis, but all others remain in their same classes for the year.
- Preschool (2-3), K-4, & K-5—that age BEFORE September 1
- 1st 6th grades—entering that grade this year regardless of age
- Youth Group—entering 7th grade this year
