Jerusalem had a temple but there was not city wall to protect the city from attack. Nehemiah provides leadership to mobilize a city-wide construction crew for the building of the wall around Jerusalem. This book provides a wonderful example of how God uses ordinary people, like Nehemiah the layman, to accomplish his extraordinary plans.
