- Preschool (2-3), K-4, & K-5—that age BEFORE September 1
- 1st 6th grades—entering that grade this year regardless of age
- Youth Group—entering 7th grade this year

Adult & Youth Fall Sunday School Classes

Basic Doctrine Overview

We may not all need a seminary degree, but there are basic teachings of the church that all of us need to know. This class will provide an overview of 17 different doctrines – one for each week of the semester - to help old and new Christians brush up on the basic teachings of our faith. Proverbs

We all need wisdom, and the book of Proverbs may be the greatest collection of wisdom ever recorded. Participants in this class will dig into the book of Proverbs to receive God's fatherly instruction for the development of wisdom and godly character in our lives. This class will be taught in the Fellowship Hall by Dan Arsenault, Chad Berry, and Mike Picone.

Daniel/Beatitudes—A Men's Class

Proverbs 27:17 tells us that "Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another." This class provides the men of Grace Church with an opportunity to sharpen one another by engaging in God's Word together and growing in relationships with one another. The first half of the class will focus on being men who stand firm under trial through a study of the life of Daniel. In the last half of the class participants will seek to grow in embracing God's values and rejecting worldliness through a study of the Beatitudes in the Sermon on the Mount. This class will be taught in the Library by Phil Bishop, Marc Sherrill, and Scott Spears.

Jonah—Youth Class (for students in 7th - 10th grade)
