

Welcome to our Thanksgiving Sharing Service

"Oh give thanks to the LORD; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples!" Psalm 105:1

It is always a blessing to hear the thanks given to the Lord for what He has been doing in our congregation. Consider the following thoughts as we give thanks to Him today:

Remember the Year

It is often hard to remember what happened last week, much less over the past year. So, take time to think through what has happened in your life this year. Ask the Lord to remind you of what events He has used to shape and form you this year.

Remember the Lord

Paul reminds us in Romans 8:28-29 that those who are in Christ can trust that every life experience is intended to be used by God for His purposes. So, as you recall specific experiences of the past year, ask the Lord to help you see His purposes in each of them.

Remember Each Other

The verse above connects giving thanks with encouraging others to seek the Lord. May we remember, as we share with others, that our goal is not to bring attention to ourselves, but to make much of God so that others will more deeply desire to follow Him.
